Trek the Track (TTT) is a group of CFA Firefighters from across Victoria who travel annually on motorcycles to the Australian Outback raising funds for the Royal Flying Doctor Service (RFDS).



We stay off the main roads where possible. We go where others
rarely do. We seek adventure. We meet the challenges head on. The Trekkers compile a record of their
adventures on video, to share the beauty, color and stark outback contrasts with others...Captured on hand held, bike and helmet

mounted HD cameras, the hundreds of hours of footage are edited into a full length movie. The movie premieres at the Wangaratta Cinema Centre, always to a sell out audience.

Having raised thousands of dollars for the RFDS, the Trekkers are seeking the support of businesses, such as yours, to enable them to continue.

<u>Proposal</u>: Over the past four years, we have battled desert dunes, severely corrogated outback tracks and rocky mountain trails, to reach our destinations. To enable us to carry our vital equipment and supplies we are supported by two 4wd vehicles, one towing a bike trailer, the other a trailer which has become known as the 'Chuckwagon'. While Chuckwagon has served us well - across 20,000km of Australia's roughest Outback tracks - our most recent trek (October 2013) saw Chuckwagon succumb to various failures, and limp home to a well earned retirement.

In order for us to continue trekking to raise funds for the RFDS, a new trailer to carry our supplies and equipment is required.
